



# Weatherization Rebate

## HOW TO APPLY

- Step 1:** Establish your eligibility by reviewing the program terms and conditions carefully. If you have questions, please contact us.
- Step 2:** **Plan your project carefully. Contact SMPA [Energy Services](#) to schedule a pre-installation inspection if you think your project will be eligible for a rebate larger than \$200.** The maximum rebate amount without a pre-installation inspection or for do-it-yourself projects is \$200.
- Step 3:** Select a contractor and complete the weatherization work.
- Step 4:** Send **1)** this application, and **2)** an invoice for the weatherization work performed and materials receipts to:

**IMPORTANT: Work performed by homeowner (do-it-yourself) or without a pre-installation inspection by SMPA will only be eligible for a weatherization rebate up to \$200.**

**IMPORTANT:** A post-installation inspection may be required in order to process rebate. If, at SMPA's sole determination, a post-installation inspection is required a SMPA representative will contact you to schedule this.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Rebate Recipient Requirements

- Rebates are available only to applicants with valid and active accounts with San Miguel Power Association.
- Work must be performed by a contractor in order to qualify for a rebate greater than \$200.
- Do-it-yourself weatherization projects may apply for rebate based on cost of materials (not labor) up to \$200 maximum rebate. Type of measure must be selected from eligible measures list. SMPA has the right to reject rebate for projects and/or materials that do not qualify.
- BPI or RESNET Energy audit prior to performing weatherization work is not required but highly recommended.
- Eligible weatherization measures:
  - Air sealing (including but not limited to: air leaks around windows, doors, power receptacles, light switches, plumbing and electrical penetrations, ceiling “can” lights, chimneys, chases, siding, baseboards and trim, tongue and groove ceilings, etc.) Blower door test recommended post air sealing.
  - Attic insulation (requires R-21 or less base value, bypass sealing required)
  - Perimeter insulation (rim joist/foundation)
  - Wall insulation (requires R-0 base value)
  - Storm windows (replacement doors and windows are not eligible)
  - Duct sealing
  - Pipe insulation
  - Vapor barrier
  - Heat recovery ventilation (new installations only)
  - Electric water heater tank insulation
- Please retain a copy of your entire submission for your records.

### Program Rules

- Retrofits only. Weatherization rebate does not apply to new construction or additions.
- Rebates are available for work performed between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017.
- Applications must be received within 180 days of purchase date or by December 31, 2017, whichever comes first.
- Maximum one weatherization rebate per utility account per year.
- SMPA Rebates are calculated after all other available incentives (not including tax credits) have been deducted.
- Rebate checks will be issued in the name of the applicant and will be issued only to complete, qualifying applications.
- Rebates are available first-come, first-served until funds are exhausted. You may call to check availability of funds.
- SMPA is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, misdirected or postage-due applications.
- SMPA reserves the right to verify compliance with these terms on **all** rebate applications, including but not limited to a physical site review.
- Qualifying applications must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations, requirements, ordinances, codes and statutes.
- All terms, conditions and rules of the program are subject to change.
- The purchase of products that are used, rebuilt, rented, leased, exchanged, won as a prize, purchased as a “buy one get one free”, purchased at auction or online auction are not eligible.
- SMPA makes no warranty of quality or performance of work completed under this program. The Weatherization rebate is an incentive offered to SMPA members to help offset the cost of residential and commercial building weatherization and efficiency retrofits. It is the SMPA Member’s responsibility to ensure that work completed under this program meets all applicable local, state, and federal codes, standards, and regulations.
